Project Highlights

Originally constructed in 1989, the three Lafayette Village properties comprise 250 total units and were acquired and rehabilitated by CHP to preserve this affordable housing stock for the community and residents of Williamsburg.

In keeping with CHP's mission to create affordable, green, sustainable housing opportunities and services, the extensive renovations of the existing property included the use of environmentally-responsible building practices and design features such as energy efficient mechanical systems, appliances, and lighting; ENERGY STAR® windows; low-VOC finishes; durable siding; and native landscaping. During the year-long rehab project, CHP also installed all-new cabinets and flooring; painted interiors and exteriors; replaced most exterior doors and some roofing; waterproofed basement areas; improved site drainage; and built community rooms in each of the three properties.
